

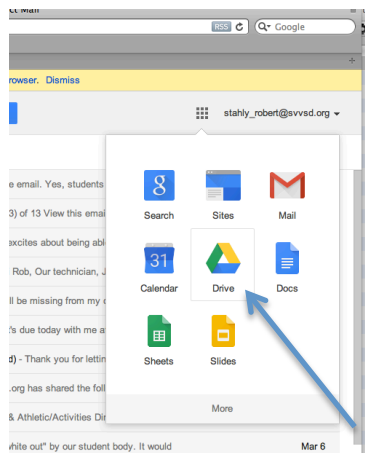

Instructions for Submission

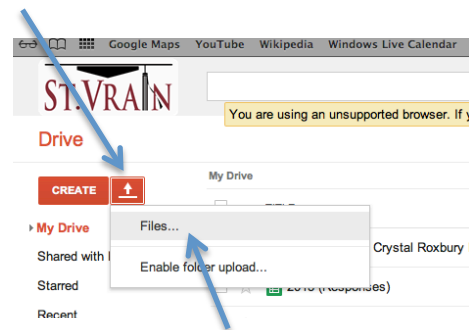
Application Form

Download the document "Application Form". It is a fillable pdf document. Fill out the document and save it as YourlastnameYourfirstnameApplication.pdf.

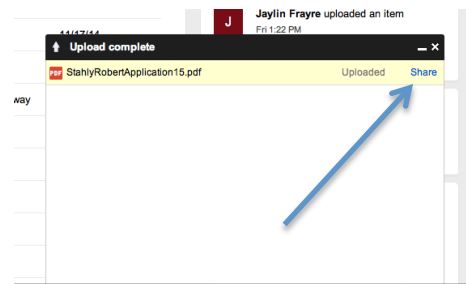
1. Using your school email account, log in to Google Drive.



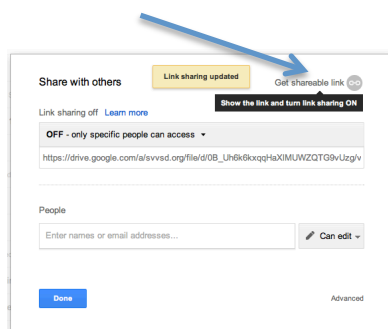
2. Upload your application pdf.



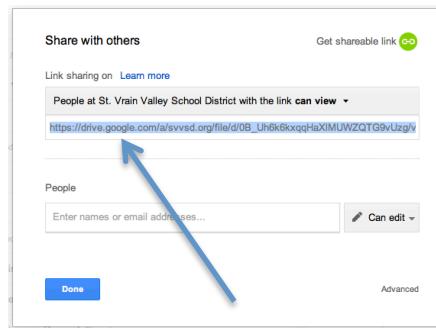
3. When the upload is finished, click "Share".

Personal Statement

When you create your personal statement letter describing your musical experiences and aspirations, save the file in pdf, doc, gdoc, or rtf format. Name the file LastnameFirstnamePersonalStatement. Upload the file to your Google Drive, and copy the shared link to your application submission, just as above.

Performance Recording

Your recording should be in the form of an audio or video recording. The recording should be longer than 2 minutes in duration and should prominently feature you as a musician. You should be the prominent figure in the video. Therefore, recordings of you performing with a large ensemble should not be submitted (unless you are a very prominent feature soloist).

Ideal submissions will be of you, by yourself, or with simple accompaniment (e.g. piano accompaniment) performing a work of music idiomatic to your study of music (not pop music) that expresses your technical and musical ability. This could be more than one work, a few short movements or large sections of works to demonstrate range would be fine. All State and Honor Group auditions are examples of ideal submissions. This recording should be made at any point during this school year.

If submitting an **audio** recording, the file should be uploaded as an mp3 or easily stream-able format (e.g. Soundcloud). Please do not upload m4a, m4r, ogg, wav, aiff, or other non-universal format to ensure that we can easily hear your submission. If you need to convert the file format, the easiest way is via iTunes. Copy a link to your recording by uploading to google drive and sharing as described above or by copying the link for your file in to the Submission form.

If submitting a **video** recording, the file should be uploaded as mov, mp4, or other universal video format. Please do not upload wmv or qt to ensure that we can easily watch your submission. You may also upload your video to YouTube or any other easily stream-able website. Copy a link to your recording by uploading to google drive and sharing as described above or by copying the link for your file in to the Submission form.
